We need enough supplies to fill a trailer. If you would like to help out, please bring any of the following items to the church office (best time to bring them is Mon-Fri.9am-2pm):

Because of their situation, they can only use certain items...the supplies needed are: **Non-perishable food; toiletries; baby items; dry milk; kitchen goods; cleaning supplies; tools; sunscreen; Soft drinks; Ensure; Enfamil; bleach; Styrofoam coolers; spade point shovels; tarps; Plastic cap roofing nails hammers/nails/crow bars; Bibles; empty boxes ones that work best are egg carton crates & banana boxes; Plastic totes to load items in**


